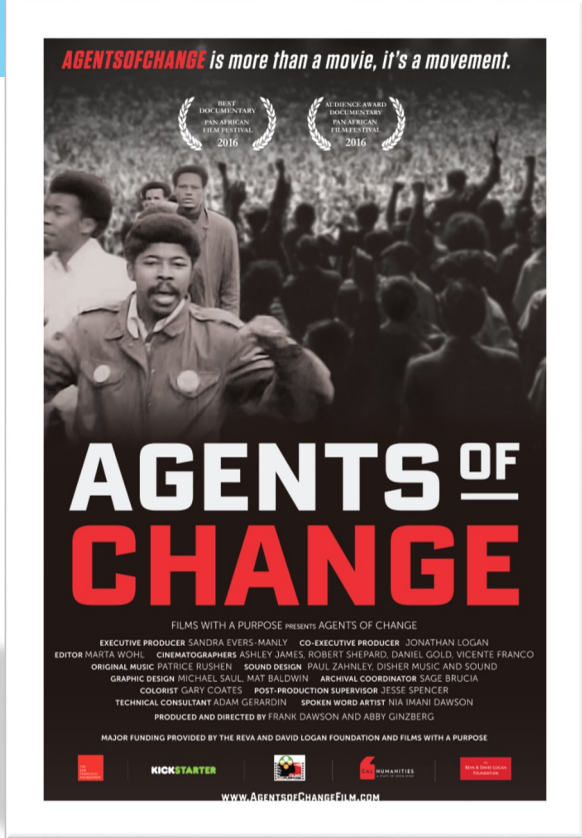

Agents of Change examines the untold story of racial conditions on college campuses that led to protests across the country at over 1,000 colleges in the late 60's.

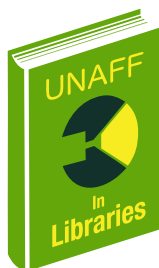
Through the stories of the film's characters who were caught at the crossroads of the civil rights and black power movements at a pivotal time in American history, their
