Afghanistan, Australia, Belgium, Brazil, Cambodia, Canada, Chile, China, Colombia, Congo, Ethiopia, France, Georgia, Germany, Guatemala, Guinea, Hungary, India, Indonesia, Iran, Iraq, Ireland, Israel, Italy, Kenya, Luxembourg, Mali, Malawi, Malaysia, Mexico, Mongolia, Morocco, Netherlands, Nigeria, Palestine, Portugal, Rwanda, South Africa, South Korea, Spain, Sudan, Sweden, Switzerland, Turkey, Uganda, UK, Ukraine, US, and Zimbabwe.

The 28th UNAFF will be held from October 16th to the 26th in Palo Alto, East Palo Alto, San Francisco, and at Stanford University.
